Policy: ID—School Day

Length of the school day for students:

- 1. The kindergarten program is a half day program and must be held at least two and one-half hours to qualify as a day of school. This is 12.5 hours per week.
- 2. In grade one, school must be held at least four and one-half hours, exclusive of lunch periods, to qualify as a day of school. This is 22.5 hours per week.
- 3. In grades two through twelve, school must be held at least five and one-half hours, exclusive of lunch periods, to qualify as a day of school. This is 27.5 hours per week.
- 4. The length of the school day for students with unusual problems may be excepted from the above requirements and established in view of the student's particular needs.
- 5. A variance from the standard length of the school day due to extraordinary circumstances such as new building construction must be approved by the State Board of Education.
