Policy: JB—Equal Education Opportunity

It is the policy of the Board of Education of the Emery County School District to provide a free appropriate education to each handicapped student within its jurisdiction, regardless of the nature or severity of the handicap.

It is the intent of the District to ensure that students who are handicapped within the definition of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 are identified, evaluated, and provided with necessary accommodations for appropriate educational services. Students may be handicapped under this policy even though they do not require services pursuant to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

Due process rights of handicapped students and their parents under Section 504 are guaranteed in the Emery County School District.

The Supervisor of Elementary Education is the compliance officer of Section 504 in the Emery County School District.
